

## BY-LAWS FOR THE ROAD KINGS

### Article 1 Name and Insignia

- Section 1. This organization shall be known as the Road Kings.
- Section 2. The organization shall have such official insignia as the membership may determine.

### Article 11 Object

- Section 1. To promote interest in various types of hot rod activities and to create an attitude of good sportsmanship and good citizenship among all its members. The object of the club shall also include the building of a competition car.

### Article 111 Membership

- Section 1. Any person of good character and owning a car with three modifications to the engine or a competition car interested in hot rod activities and holding a valid drivers license. Is eligible for active membership in this organization with full privileges thereof.
- Section 2. All applications for membership must be in writing. Each applicant must have a well kept and good running car.
- Section 3. All applications for membership must be sponsored by a member in good standing and names of all applicants for membership must be read at regular meetings. Applicants must be present at three meetings before being voted upon and may be rejected by a three-member blackball.
- Section 4. Any member may be reprimanded or expelled for violating the rules by a majority vote of the members present at any regular meeting or a special meeting called by the officers.
- Section 5. Any member may withdraw his membership by submitting an oral request stating his reasons for withdrawal. He may be reinstated at his request by paying his dues upon return, being voted in and initiated.
- Section 6. Any member may go to an inactive status by submitting an oral request at any regular meeting. By stating his reasons subject to approval of the clubmembers, by a majority vote. The member will be otherwise be dropped if he so wishes.
- A. Upon re-entrance the member will pay a one dollar (\$1.00) reinstatement fee plus his first months dues.
- Section 7. Any member being absent three (3) meetings in a row, without notification or a valid excuse, will be dropped from the club.
